### When can students return their books?

Preferable in the morning of your class visit to be ready for the library visit during the day. Books can be returned anytime but they may only be processed when staff have time.

### Late or Overdue Books:

Overdue notices are sent to teachers/ home group teachers approximately every two weeks. Students are NOT allowed to borrow any other books while they have overdue books. If the book is lost a replacement cost is requested, and can be paid to the front office.
